# THE DOCTRINE OF THE TRINITY (बिएक परमेश्वर)

- 1. The Teaching of the 'Trinity' is the foundational teaching of the Christian faith. All other teachings flow from this teaching.
- 2. Our God is a Triune 3 in 1; thus, we say 3 "Persons" in 1 God
- 3. The 3 "Persons" of the Trinity are separate but equal.
- 4. The Doctrine of the Trinity is strictly monotheistic (one God).

### The Doctrine of the Trinity

- 5. The doctrine of the Trinity is clearly founded in scripture -- each has a will, each speaks and each is called 'God'.
- 6. We can only believe in the Trinity through the light of faith (the gift of faith).
- 7. Creation gives us glimpses as to how God can be <u>three in one</u> (Ex: fire, the clover, musical chord, etc.).







# DOCTRINAL BASIS OF UESI ON TRINITY







# How is the Trinity derived from scripture?

- We see in the Old Testament, scripture that demonstrate a plurality concerning God.
- "Then God said, 'Let <u>Us</u>(<u>ELOHIM</u>) make man in Our image, according to Our likeness..." (Gen. 1:26).
- "And the Spirit of God was hovering over the face of the waters..." --Genesis.1:2

The Baptism of Jesus: We see the Trinity at work: (Matt.3:13-17)

Baptismal formula: Go ye....
(Matt.28:19)

Benediction: The grace of the Lord..... (2 Cor.13:14).

# How is the Trinity derived from scripture?

- We see that the Father, the Son, and the Holy Spirit are each called God.
  - The Father: पिता
  - "Grace to you and peace from God our Father and the Lord Jesus Christ," (Phil. 1:2).
  - <u>The Son</u>: पुत्र
  - "But of the Son He says, 'Thy throne, O God, is forever and ever..." (Heb. 1:8). See also, Jn.1:1,14.

### The Holy Spirit: पवित्र अत्मा

"But Peter said, 'Ananias, why has Satan filled your heart to lie to the Holy Spirit, and to keep back some of the price of the land? 4"...Why is it that you have conceived this deed in your heart? You have not lied to men, but to God," (Acts 5:3-4).

# HOW IS THE TRINITY DERIVED FROM SCRIPTURE?

...continued

We see that the Father, the Son, and the Holy Spirit each <u>speak</u>: (उनकी वाणी)

#### The Father:

"and behold, a voice out of the heavens, saying, "This is My beloved Son, in whom I am well-pleased," (Matt. 3:17).

#### The Son:

"For God so loved the world, that He gave His only begotten Son, that whoever believes in Him should not perish, but have eternal life," (John 3:16).

#### The Holy Spirit:

"And while they were ministering to the Lord and fasting, the Holy Spirit said, "Set apart for Me Barnabas and Saul for the work to which I have called them," (Acts 13:2)

# How is the Trinity derived from scripture?

> We see that the Father, the Son, and the Holy Spirit each have a will: इच्चा

#### The Father:

"For this is the will of My Father, that everyone who beholds the Son and believes in Him, may have eternal life," (John 6:40).

#### • The Son:

"Father, if You are willing, remove this cup from Me; yet not My will, but Yours be done." (Luke 22:42).

### • The Holy Spirit:

"But one and the same Spirit works all these things, distributing to each one individually just as He wills." (1 Cor. 12:11)

# Trinity acting in Unity In Creation: सुष्टी

• God spoke: "Let there be light (Ge.1:3).

• God the Son, spoken word. (Jn.1:1)

### In Redemption छुट्कारा

 God the Father has accepted the sacrifice of His Son. (Heb.9:14)

 God the Son offered Himself as our substitute. (Heb.9:14).

 God the Spirit - Jesus offered Himself "through the Eternal Spirit".

### In Communion सम्मिलत

 God the Father invites us to come to Him for fellowship. (Eph.2:18)

God the Son is the Reconciliation.
 (2Cor.5:19).

• God the Spirit effects this union and communion. (Eph.2:18).

### **In Prayer**

 God the Father is the One who receives our requests. (Jn.16:23).

 God the Son is the One in whose name we pray. (Jn16:23)

 God the Spirit directs us in our requests. (Rom.8:26)

## In Glory महिमा

 God the Father eventually receives the Millennial Kingdom (1 cor.15:24)

 God the Son will change our earthly bodies to glorified bodies. (Phi.3:21)

 God the Spirit gives the invitation. (Rev.22:17) □ Lord our God is one. (Deu.6:4)

■ No man has seen God. (Jn.1:18, 1 Jn.4:12)

Life of Christ: Incarnation, Crucifixion, Resurrection, Ascension and Second Coming.

☐ The Ascension of Christ - Exalted Conqueror.

After Ascension, His earthly ministry is complete.

Jesus is seated at the right hand of God and is interceding for us. (Eph.1:20). and preparing mansion for us.

The Holy Spirit came to indwell in believers after Christ's ascension. (Jn.16:7, Acts.2:2).


The Holy Spirit has been sent by the Father and Son to indwell and guide believers and abide in the living Church of Christ. (Jn.14:16)
